**Minutes of a meeting of the Planning and Highways Committee held on Tuesday the
29th October 2013 at 7.00pm in the Council Chamber.**

01 APOLOGIES FOR ABSENCE

- a) Apologies were received from Cllr Proctor due to being on vacation.
- b) Apologies from Cllr Proctor were duly accepted.

02 DECLARATIONS OF INTEREST

- a) Members were provided with the opportunity under the Localism Act 2011 to declare any pecuniary interests or dispensations to participate in the meeting. There were none declared.
- b) The Committee Clerk had not received any dispensation requests.

03 OPEN FORUM

Mr Marteau - spoke regarding agenda item 4.8, 22 St James Street and acknowledged that his response was partially an emotive response but also legalistic. He provided a report of his opinions which in summary included that the development contravened policy SB4, that it negatively impacted on the character and appearance of the conservation area and negatively impacted the neighbouring listed buildings.

Mr Newton - spoke regarding agenda item 4.8, 22 St James Street reporting that 30% of his view of the vale is lost as a result of the development. He expressed a desire that developments were carried out in the spirit of the community.

Mr Perry - spoke regarding agenda item 4.8, 22 St James Street that he believed the building was further forward than the drawings indicated.

DCllr Pritchard - spoke regarding agenda item 4.8, 22 St James Street explaining that although he became aware of it through Shaftesbury Town Council, it was in his capacity as a District Councillor that he had approached the planning manager at NDDC to express concern. Although not the ward member for the application, the ward member would have been put in an awkward position as the partner of the architect. He reported that if the committee were minded to ask the application to go to committee at NDDC, he would be permitted to attend as representative.

Mr Unwin - spoke regarding agenda item 4.1, 4 French Mill Lane expressing concerns relating to the veranda as it would then face their house and regarding the single storey extension. He also expressed the observation that the proposed garage was a substantial structure and 2 storeys tall, he believed that being in an Interesting Open Wooded Area (IOWA) he believed that would not be allowable.

Mr Thompson - spoke regarding agenda item 4.1, 4 French Mill Lane as owner and architect, he confirmed that he had written to Mr and Mrs Unwin to discuss proposals. In response to the query of it being an IOWA, he had confirmation from the tree officers at North Dorset District Council that the proposals were acceptable. He added that he would be happy with grey slate tiles to accommodate the views of his neighbours but that he would not be happy moving the location of the veranda as it would provide them with privacy.
