Public Participation

PH89 Order of Business

It was **AGREED** to amend the order of business to consider application 2/2016/1868/FUL St Denis Lodge as the first item under Planning Applications.

2/2016/1868/FUL - St Denis Lodge Salisbury Road Shaftesbury SP7 8BS

Erect three storey and single storey extensions. Form vehicular access and 1 No. additional parking space to create 16 No. in total. (Demolish adjacent single storey dwelling and close existing access).

Applicant: St Denis Lodge Ltd Agent: Proctor Watts Cole Rutter

Observations: OBJECTION. The Committee objected to the application due to concerns about the loss of privacy and light for neighbouring properties and concern about road safety with the proposed new access on to the C13/B3081.

2/2017/0001/CATREE - St James Lodge Raspberry Lane Shaftesbury SP7 8HN

- T1- Ginkgo tree Crown reduction, remove between 4-5 feet of height.
- T2- Yew tree Crown reduction, remove 1 foot.
- T3- Bay tree Remove first 2 limbs of trunk closest to building, over hanging roof, to take away the threat of damage.

Tree Group comments: We should prefer the gingko not to be pruned if possible, but have no objections to the other proposals.

OBSERVATIONS: The Committee supported the view of the Shaftesbury Tree Group, that the gingko not be pruned if possible and no objections to the other proposals.

2/2017/0008/TPTREE Dorset Foods Ltd, Longmead Industrial Est, Shaftesbury, Dorset, SP7 8PL

T1 - Lawson Cypress (x33) - Reduce the height of the row of trees by 3m

Tree Group Comments: We presume TPOs were placed on this hedge of Lawson cypresses to screen the industrial estate from the town. We could not get close to the trees, but they are visible from Longmead and other places and look rather overgrown. Another part of this screen has recently been pruned. No objections.

<u>2/2017/0105/CATREE - Fountain Inn Breach Lane Shaftesbury Dorset SP7 8LE</u> T1, T2 and T3 - Fir - Overgrown fir trees overhanging 6 Castle Hill Drive, Fell

OBSERVATIONS: The Committee expressed concern and requested more information on the ownership of the trees following a comment noted on the NDDC application details and OBJECTED to the felling.
