The Council supported the application in principle provided there is a legal agreement ensuring the sports pitches were forthcoming. The Council reserves the right to consider each stage of the planning process on its merits at the appropriate time and proffer different views if it deems appropriate at each stage. Support of the application is subject to a suitable traffic impact assessment and sustainable travel plan for the sports pitches at planning stage. It was acknowledged that the application was outside the development area, the Council considered that the balance of gain for the overall scheme outweighed the negative impact of the additional houses.
