6.1 Summary

- 6.1.1 Dorset Council have sent notification of a proposed weight restriction order for consideration and invited comments to be submitted by 2nd March 2022. The effect of the Order will be to prohibit any vehicle, in excess of 7.5 tonnes maximum gross weight, from proceeding on:
 - A section of Foyle Hill from its junction with Coles Lane in an easterly direction to its junction with the B3091.
 - A section of the B3091 from its junction with Coles Lane in an easterly direction to its junction with the B3091.
